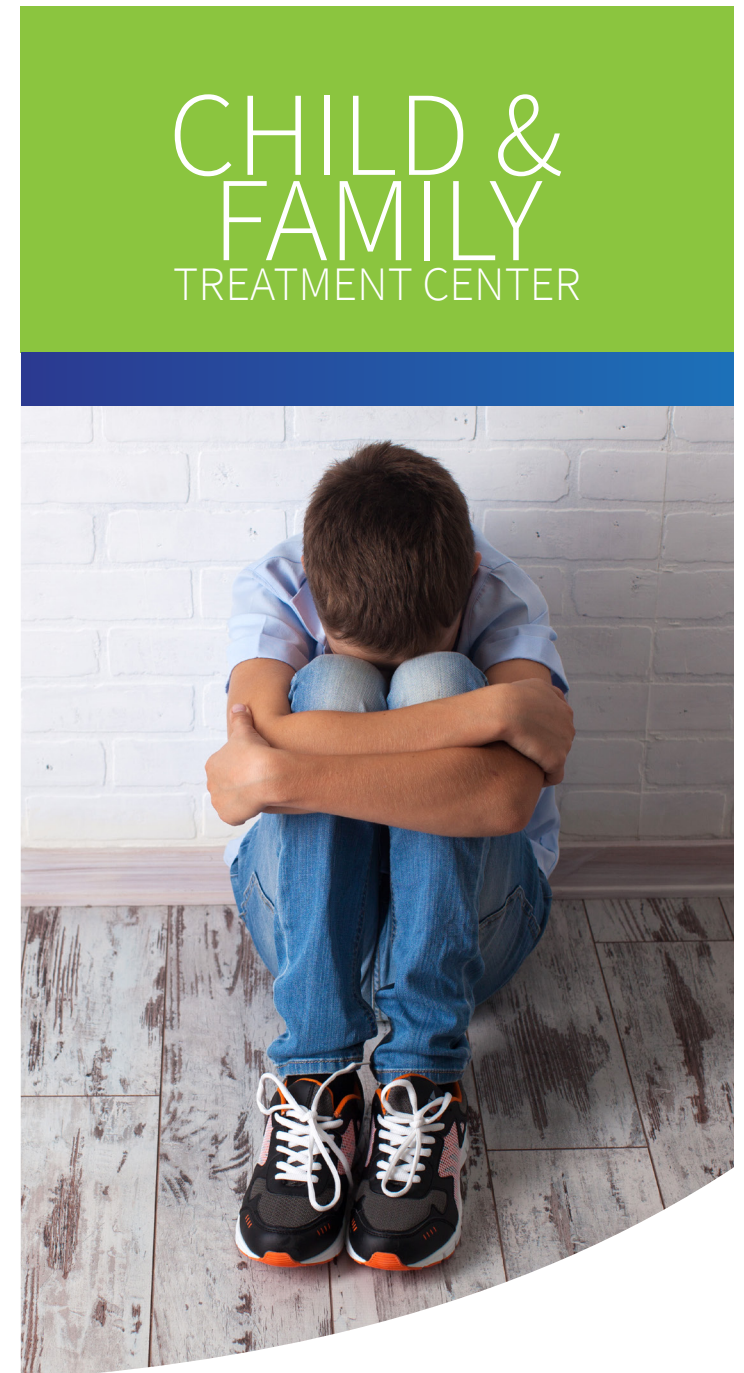

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# CHILD & FAMILY TREATMENT CENTER





The Child & Family Treatment Center includes Child and Adolescent Counseling Services, Young Child Institute, Ready To Learn School-Based Services, and Connections for Life.

We provide diagnostic evaluations, treatment and school-based prevention services to children birth to 18 and their families.

Our multidisciplinary staff includes child psychiatrists, child psychologists, clinical social workers, clinical counselors, and child case managers.

We provide training and placement for graduate students in counseling, psychology, social work and psychiatry.

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### Professional help is indicated when children have:

- Difficulties in interpersonal relationships with family, peers and/or others
- Difficulties in adjustment to family stress or crisis (illness, moves, divorce and/or loss)
- Dangerous or self-destructive behaviors
- Symptoms of depression and/or anxiety; sleeping or eating problems
- School attendance, adjustment and achievement problems, or attention deficit / hyperactivity disorder
- Psychological consequence of abuse or other trauma

### Connections For Life

**Utilizes a mental health therapist, occupational therapist, and speech and language pathologist**

- For children under 5 years of age, evaluation of the child's developmental, behavioral, and sensorimotor function and communication skills
- Caregiver/child therapy that incorporates the concerns for the whole child in each session
- Other services such as psychological assessment and medication management
